FALMOUTH - FLUSHING - MYLOR HARBOUR -FLUSHING - FALMOUTH.

A ferry ride, marvellous harbour views, a quaint village, an old church and some farmland.

- A The walk starts at the Prince of Wales pier Falmouth, grid reference SW808 330.Catch the ferry for the short sail across the harbour to Flushing Quay. At the end of the quay turn right in front of Pitick Terrace and turn left at no. 6 up the alley to Trefusis Road. Turn right and walk along the road, following it round as it swings to the left. Proceed to the end of this long road and go through the metal gate at the end into the Trefusis Estate.
- B Continue ahead on the wide track through the trees and then through another gate into a field. Follow the track across the field towards the water, then bear left with the track and continue ahead with the water on your right to the outskirts of Mylor Harbour (Churchtown). Go on past a boat park and the Restronget Sailing club to the road. Continue through the village and turn left into the churchyard by the telephone box. Where the path splits take the right path up by the side of the church to go out through the lych gate and onto the road by the War Memorial.
- Cross directly over and take the path by **Angarrack**. When it becomes a road continue ahead. Just after it turns very sharply to the right take the signed public footpath on the left by the house sign for 27 **Trelew Vean**. Continue to the public footpath on your left just before a metal farm gate. Take this path following it round to the right as it wanders through the trees. When you come into an open area go ahead through the gate and follow the rough track up hill, keeping the hedge on your right when you come out into a field. Continue uphill to a road.
- D Turn left to the road junction and go straight across and along the drive of **Trefusis Barton** farmhouse. Turn right through the gate just after the cattle grid. Follow the path left across the corner of the field and cross the stile. Turn immediately right down the field with the hedge on your right. At the bottom go over the stile to the right of the houses and follow the path down to the road. Turn right down the hill and left at the bottom to take you back to **Flushing Quay** and the ferry to **Falmouth**.
